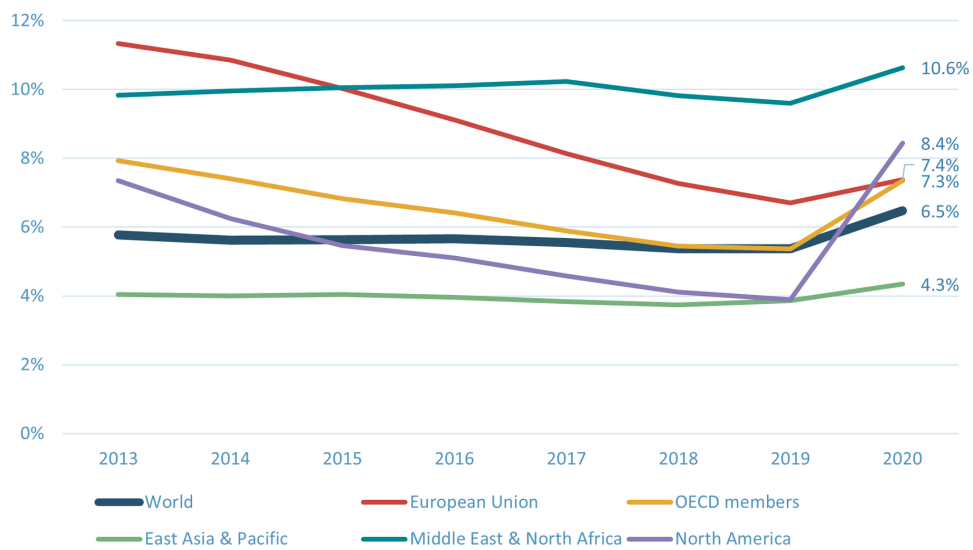

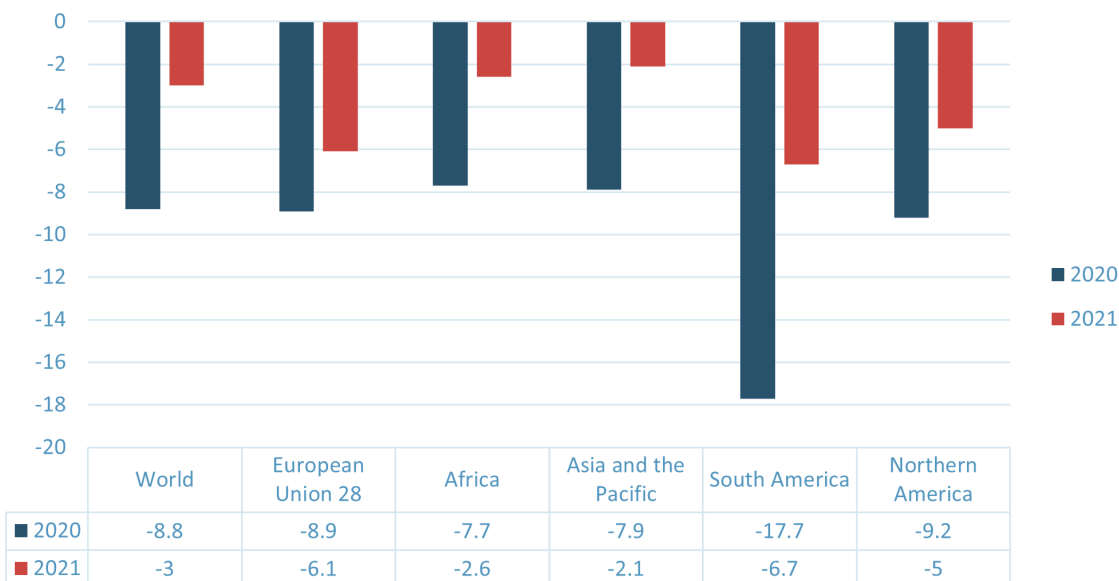

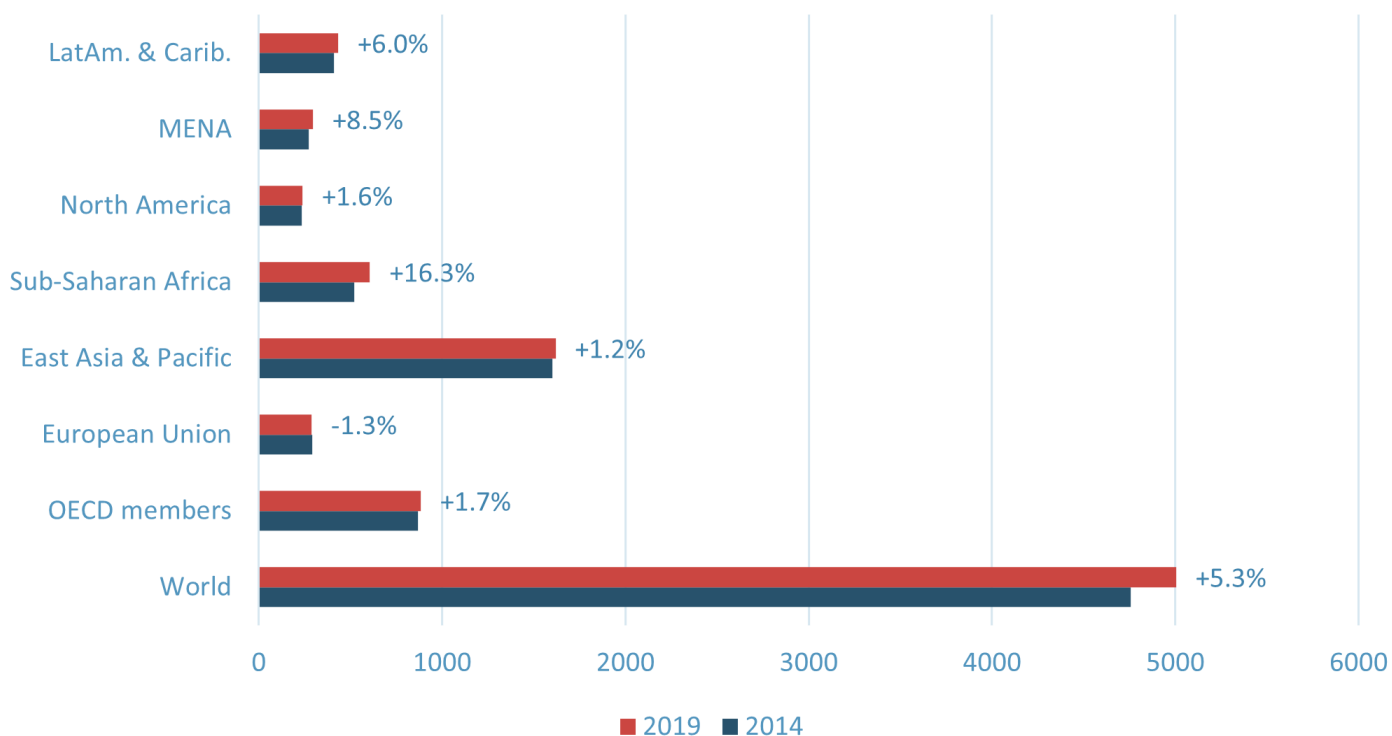
Working hours lost compared to Q4 2019 (%)

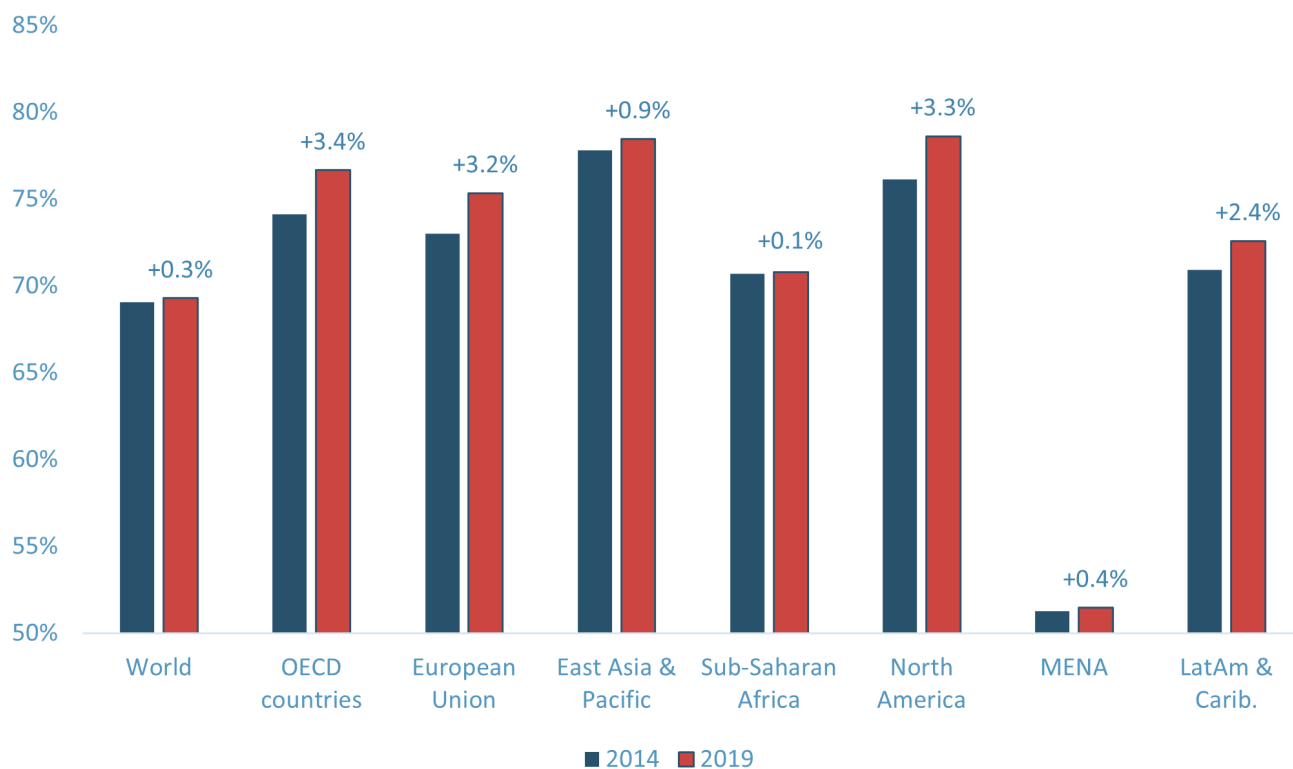
Labour markets during Covid-19

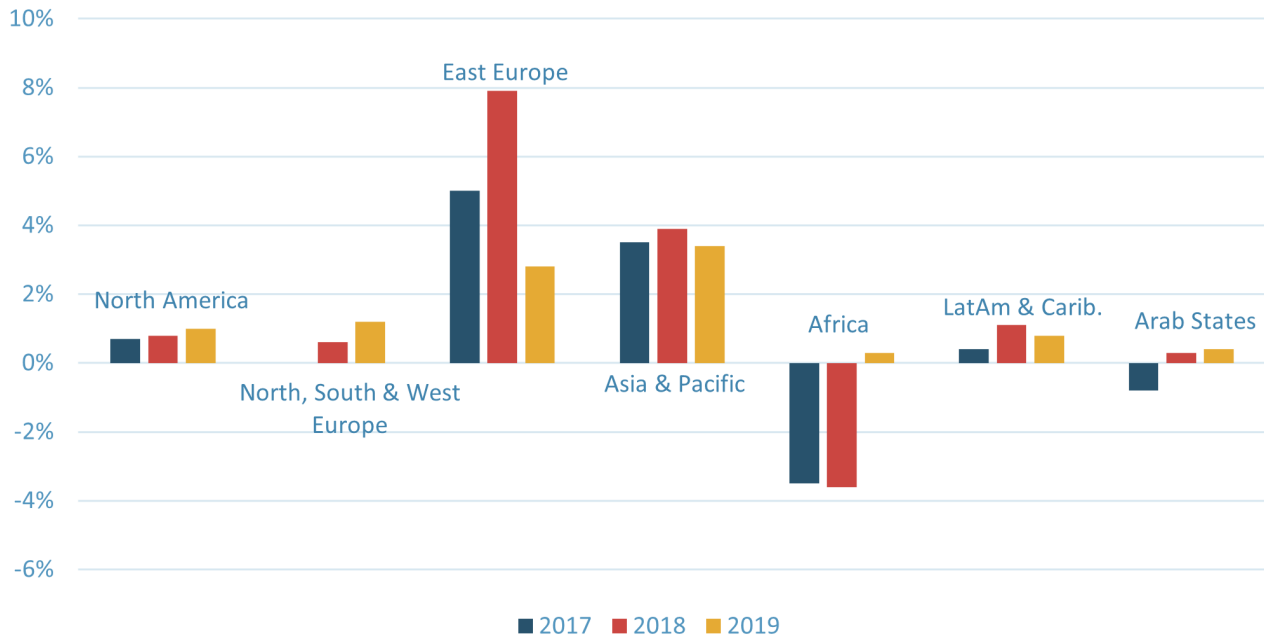
Labour force participation rate (%) 2014-2019, 5-year % change

# Wage Evolution

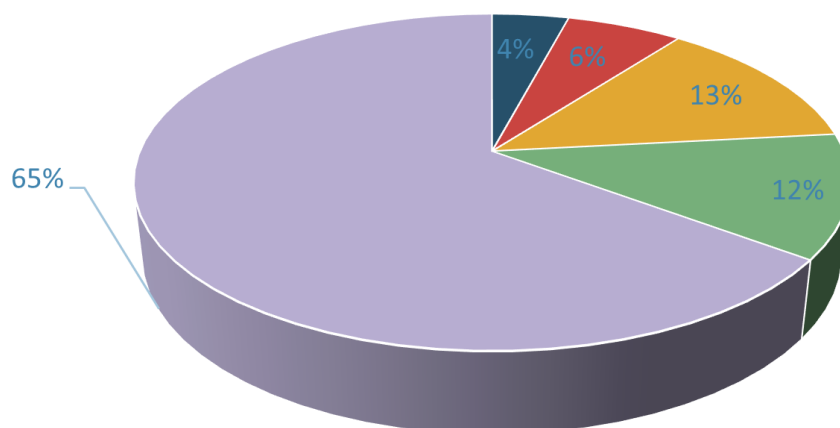
Average annual real wage growth

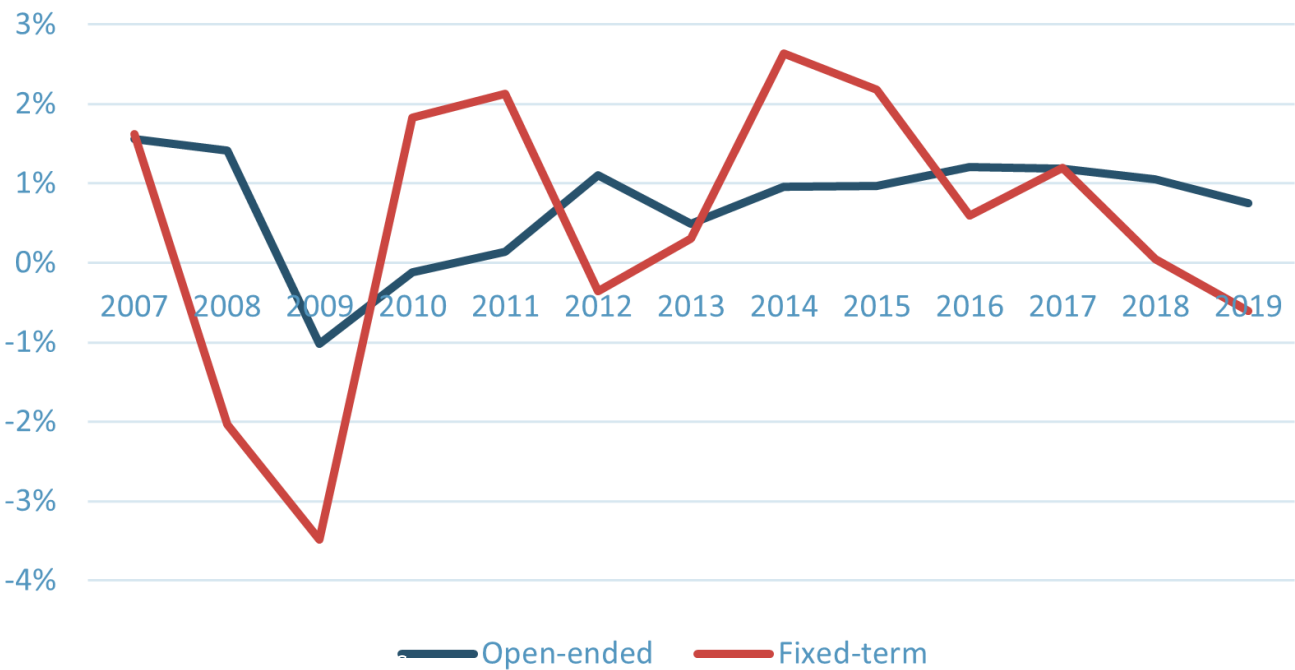
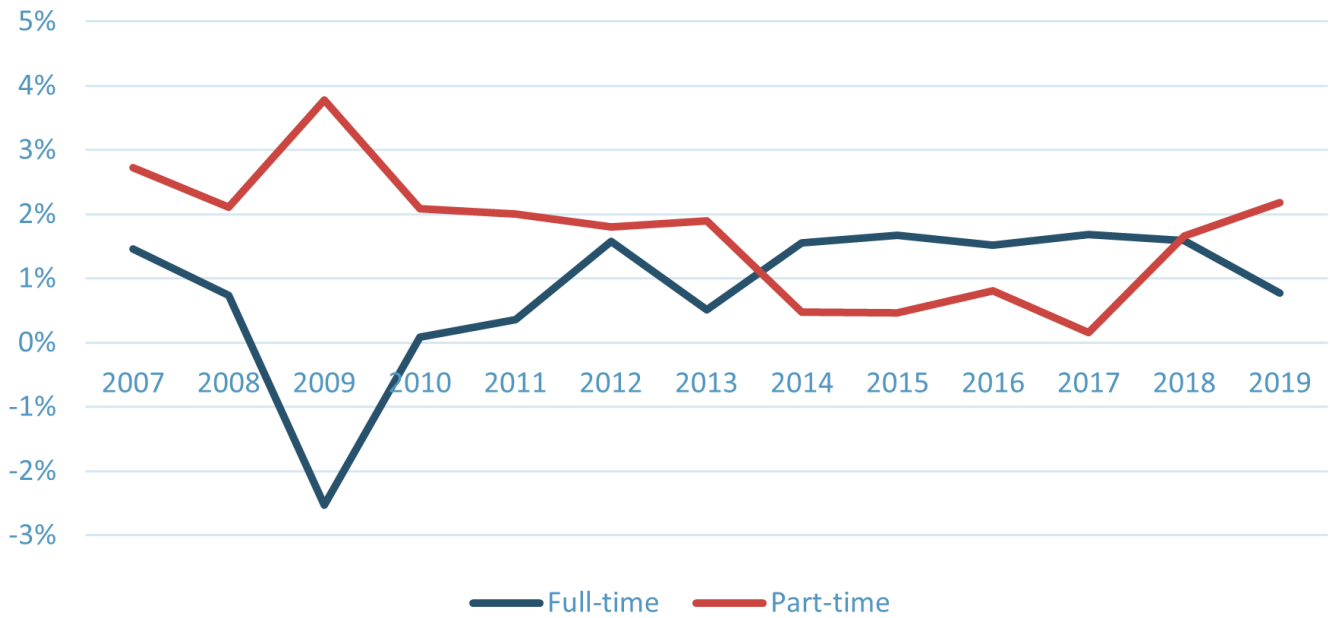
Employment by sector, OECD, Q4 2019
